*The District meets all statutory teacher salary minimum requirements through utilization of the salary schedule and additional Teacher Salary Supplement (TSS) Allocations.

School & Community

The Mount Pleasant Community School District encompasses 303 square miles and includes four elementary schools (PK-5), one middle school (6-8) and one senior high school (9-12). For the 2024-2025 school year, there were 1,800 students and approximately 350 employees in the district. The district has finished additions to two elementary schools and also completed a new senior high. in addition, the middle school has had and expansion and renovation.

Mount Pleasant is a community of over 8,000 in Southeast lowa. It is located at the crossroads of US Highway 34 and US Highway 218, also known as the Avenue of the Saints because of the outstanding transportation network, ten Fortune 500 companies have facilities in Mount Pleasant. One of the top 100 hospitals in rural America, Henry County Health Center.

There are many recreational activities available in the 230 acres of parks that are maintained by the city.
